### ***Important Note Regarding Part 2, Lesson 7***

In *The Blue Teacher Book* Part 2, Lesson 7 *Noah's Ark* by Linda Hayward (ISBN: 9780394887166 ©1987) is used as additional literature. This book is currently out of print although it may be available in used bookstores or online. If you cannot obtain this book, please make the following changes in the lesson:

#### **Part 2, Lesson 7:**

- Page 41, **Materials Needed** reads, “**Noah’s Ark.**”  
Replace with – “**a Bible storybook version of Noah’s Ark.**”
- Page 44, 4.2 reads, “**Read the book, Noah’s Ark, to your student.**”  
Replace with – “**Read a Bible storybook version of Noah’s Ark to your student.**”
- Page 44, 4.3 reads, “**Discuss the book with your student. Ask him what he liked or didn’t like. Spend some time looking at the details of the pictures and noticing expressions on faces.**”  
Replace with – “**Discuss the story with your student. Ask him what he liked or didn’t like. Spend some time discussing the details of the story and how Noah and his family might have felt about the animals.**”
- Page 44, 4.4 – reads, “**Give your student the book, and using the pictures, have him retell the story.**”  
Replace with – “**After discussing the story of Noah’s Ark with your student, have him retell the story.**”
